



## OPERATIONS SUPERVISOR

The North Yorkshire Moors Railway invites applications for the post of Operations Supervisor.

Reporting to Operations Manager, Norman Hugill, and acting as his deputy, this is an important position within this premier heritage railway. The successful applicant will play a vital role in the safe and efficient running of train services between Pickering and Grosmont – together, uniquely for a heritage railway, with NYMR operations over Network Rail's Esk Valley Line to Whitby and Battersby.

Specific responsibilities include:

- Supervision of operations standards;
- Monitoring the safe working of signalmen, guards and other operating staff, including routine inspection visits and ride outs;
- Undertaking initial rules examinations and biennial assessments of signalmen/guards;
- Carry out operational checks on level crossings, engineering and other activities affecting the safety of the railway;
- Investigation of incidents and train performance issues;
- Signalman/Guard's duties as required and assistance to the Operations Manager.

A minimum of 5 years operational experience is required, with an ability to demonstrate a good knowledge of both signaling and train working. Some experience in a supervisory or managerial capacity would also be an advantage. Weekend and Bank Holidays working will be required, and the position includes an 'On call' commitment.

The post is being offered on a seasonal basis initially (March to November), however, for the right candidate, opportunity may exist for this to be extended and for the role to be developed.
